## Terrell County Offers Convenience of Online Vehicle Registration Renewal

## Residents Have Fast, Easy Way to Renew Vehicle Registration

**Sanderson, Texas** – December 18, 2013-Clint McDonald, Terrell Tax Assessor, is pleased to offer the convenience of online vehicle registration renewals to the residents of Terrell. This year, Texans have saved considerable time by renewing nearly 2.2 million vehicle registrations online, and Terrell is also encouraging its citizens to take advantage of this easy, secure, and fuel-efficient service.

"We continually strive to provide the residents of Terrell with exceptional customer service," said Clint McDonald, Tax Assessor. "Being able to offer online vehicle registration renewal is just one way that we can better meet the needs of our citizens. And, it also helps our office streamline processes and operate more efficiently."

Residents can access the online vehicle registration renewal link from <u>Texas.gov</u>, <u>Texas.gov</u>/<u>Driver</u>, or the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles website, <u>www.txdmv.gov</u>. To renew online, you must have these three items on hand:

- vehicle identification number (VIN)
- license plate number
- insurance information

You can renew your registration sticker for up to three years. There is also an option to sign up for a friendly <u>e-mail reminder</u> that lets you know when your registration expiration date is approaching. The cost to renew online includes a \$2.00 Texas.gov administration fee and a \$1.00 'mail-in fee' that covers the Terrell's cost to process and mail the sticker to you.

Online transactions are securely processed by <u>Texas.gov</u>, the official website for the state of Texas. In addition to offering vehicle registration renewal, Texas.gov provides more than 1,000 online services such as driver license renewal, birth certificate orders, CHIP enrollment fee payments, professional licensing, and more.
